Run for your life!*

FORGIVENESS



FORGIVE TO LIVE.

Forgiveness is a most difficult decision and process. But (because?!) it is life-essential.

- **BDAG: ἀφίημι *aphiēmi*** “to dismiss or release someone or something from a place or one’s presence; let go, send away, give up, emit, divorce; to release from legal or moral obligation or consequence, cancel, remit, pardon - Mt 6:12 referenced!”
- **Forgiveness** is the only indicative (fact & reality-oriented verb) in the Lord’s Prayer (Mt 6:12)!
- **Human forgiveness** (Mt 18:21-22): based on God’s own example towards His people (457 BC - 34 AD=490!)
 **Case Study:** Joseph thrown in the pit by his brothers - sold (Gen 37) - **forgives!** → **Gen 50:20!**
