CHILDREN "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it" (Prov 22:6)

Train חנך אhanakh: "to train up; to dedicate" (BDB 335; HALOT 334) a house (Deut 20:5; 1 Kgs 8:63; 2 Chr 7:5). Noun חנר khanukhah : "dedication; consecration" esp. of altars (Num 7:10; 2 Chr 7:9), the temple (Ps 30:1), town walls (Neh חניך. Adj. חניך khanikh: "trained, tried, experienced" men (BDB 335; Gen 14:14). Aram. "to train," Eth. "to initiate," Arab. "to learn; to make experienced". Also rubbing a newborn's palate of with date juice or olive oil 6 to motivate child to suck, but Arabic meaning until nearly a millennium later. [NET Bible note adaptation]

Child נַעַר na'ar, omwaana, mtoto, but also "youth" or broad range of ages (врв 654-55; нацот 707): infant (Ex 2:6), weaned child (1 Sam 1:24), young child (Jer 1:6), lad (Gen 22:12), adolescent (Gen 37:2), or young man of marriageable age (Gen 34:19) = formative years. Talmud: < age 25.

Go עַל־פִּי דַּרְכּוֹ 'al pi darko: "according to his way"; NEB "Start a boy on the right road." "The way he should go" = a standard of life to be attained: the way of the wise/righteousness vs the way of the fool. One takes training, the other does not. Ralbag's corollary: "Train a child according to his evil inclinations (let him have his will) and he will continue in his evil way throughout life" (J. H. Greenstone, Proverbs, 234).

Froblem. Solution. Read carefully and prayerfully the life of our dear Saviour when He dwelt among men upon the earth. Imitate His life, and you will not be found straying from the narrow path. We utterly refuse to be conscience for you. If we tell you just what to do, you will look to us to guide you, instead of going directly to Jesus for yourselves. Your experience will be founded in us. You must have an experience for yourselves, which shall be founded in God. Then can you stand amid the perils of the last days and be purified and not consumed by the fire of affliction through which all the saints must pass in order to have the impurities removed from their character preparatory to receiving the finishing touch of immortality" (2T 118.3).
